

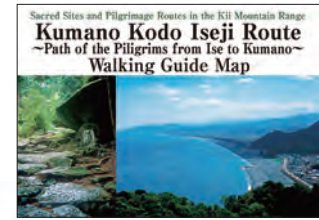

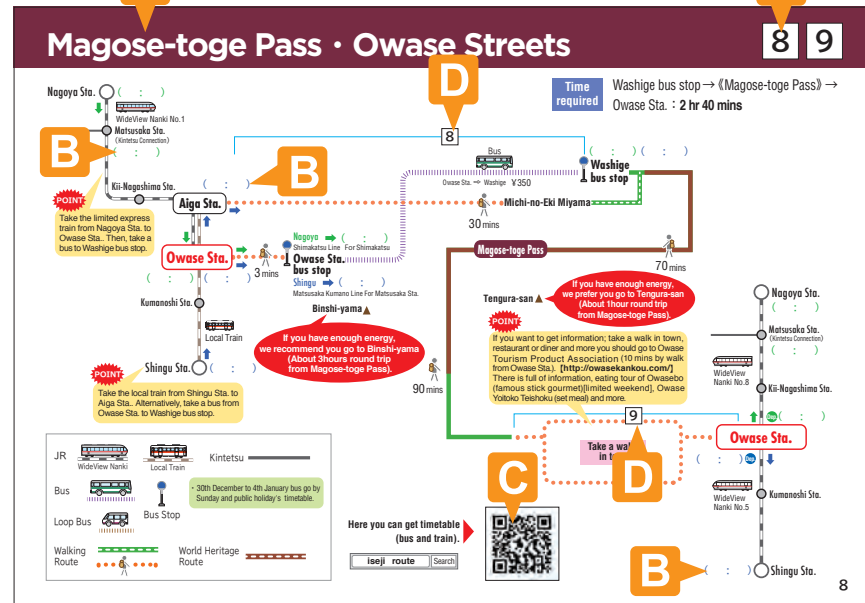

Marks of Iseji

■ Signposts on the Passes

While walking along any of the passes listed on the UNESCO World Heritage List, you will see “Iseji Route Signposts” at intervals of about 100 meters. Those signposts help you to know exactly where you are and call for help in an emergency such as an injury or a sudden illness. When you call for help, please inform the police station or fire station of the “Pass Number” and “Signpost Number” indicated on the nearest signpost for a quick rescue.

Note: you may have very poor cell-phone reception in some areas when you walk along a pass.



Emblem of World Heritage

This is official emblem of World Heritage [Sacred Sites and Pilgrimage Routes in the Kii Mountain Range]. Emblem is using traffic sign, and show the registered assets of World Heritage like [milestone of Iseji] that set on the pass in that area.

Emblem also printed on the official brochure too.



■ What to Do in Case of a Tsunami

Generally, coastal areas located at low altitudes may face a risk of tsunamis caused by an earthquake. Please be sure to evacuate immediately to any of the designated shelters with the sign of “Tsunami Evacuation Area” or “Tsunami Evacuation Building” or the like.



You will see the sign on the upper part of the utility pole (shown in the photograph) in the areas facing a risk of tsunamis caused by an earthquake. Meanwhile, the sign on the lower part of the pole indicates the altitude of the area.

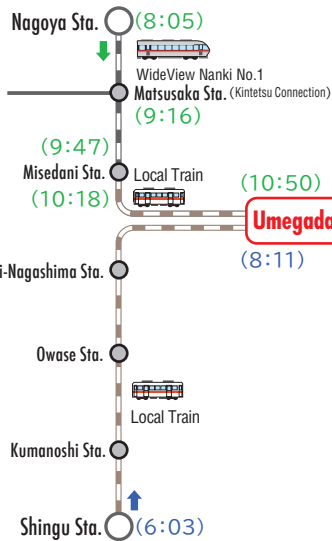
Emblem of Kumano Kodo Iseji

Sacred Sites and Pilgrimage Routes in the Kii Mountain Range

Kumano Kodo Iseji Route



World Heritage Site - The Way of the Kumano Faith

The 'sacred sites and pilgrimage routes in the Kii Mountain Range' were designated as a World Cultural Heritage Site in 2004. Making up the World Heritage Site are the three sacred sites of '**Kumano Sanzan**' (the three grand shrines), '**Yoshino and Omine**', and '**Koyasan**', as well as the pilgrimage routes that connect them ('**Kumano Sankeimichi (the Kumano Kodo)**', '**Omine Okugakemichi**', and '**Koyasan Choishimichi**').

The Kumano Kodo is the pilgrimage route people take to visit the three grand shrines that make up the Kumano Sanzan (Kumano Hongu Taisha, Kumano Nachi Taisha, and Kumano Hayatama Taisha). In the past, several routes have been used to visit the shrines including those originating from Ise, Yoshino, Koyasan, and Kyoto. However, the most exemplary routes are the Kiiji route which runs down the Kii Peninsula from the west and the Iseji route which begins at the Ise Grand Shrine to the east.

The Iseji route is a route leading into the sacred Kumano area. It is full of numerous steep mountain passes and is frequently travelled along by both those visiting the Ise Grand Shrine and those journeying along the Saigoku Kannon Pilgrimage.

- There are stamp posts located close to mountain ridges along all Kumano Kodo courses. Please use these stamps on the designated spots on your stamp sheet. You are free to visit these posts in any order you wish.
- You may use only one stamp sheet per person.
- Please be aware that stamp sheets lacking stamps in the designated spaces or sheets that have been stamped by stamps other than those specified are void.

- Stamp posts are placed at every spot marked  on all course maps.
- There are two stamp spots around Hamakaido. You need only stamp once.
- We will stamp and return all correctly completed stamp sheets upon inspection.
