WIMBERLEY & DRIFTWOOD, TEXAS

Continue to Driftwood, where the air is rich with the mouthwatering scent of Texas barbecue. Share a smoked brisket platter beneath a canopy of oak trees, then sip local wines in a laid-back vineyard setting. It's a perfect blend of nature, flavor, and small-town charm, just a short drive from the big city.

AUSTIN, TEXAS

With its bold energy and boundless creativity, just under three hours south, Austin is more than a city, it's a vibe. Spend your day walking through neighborhoods alive with street art, music shops, and vintage boutiques. Paddleboard across the calm waters of Lady Bird Lake for a midday recharge, or climb to the hilltop parks for sweeping skyline views. As evening rolls in, the live music scene takes center stage, whether you're catching a rising star in a candlelit bar or dancing to a local band under the stars.
