PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA

Welcome to **Philadelphia**, which 17th-century Englishman and province founder William Penn envisioned as an easily navigable urban utopia. Today, view over 4,000 outdoor murals that provide an incredible art trail while exploring historic places in this walkable city. Plan your own route using **Mural Arts Philadelphia's** mobile app; include stops at three of the most famous murals – “Legends,” “Philadelphia Muses” and “Common Threads.” Don't forget to pose for a photo at the **LOVE statue** before stopping for lunch at **Reading Terminal Market**, a culinary experience that is the perfect place to order a Philadelphia cheesesteak. Visiting **Independence National Historic Park** is a must to see over 20 historical sites that include the **Liberty Bell** and **Independence Hall**. “Rocky” movie fans won't want to miss the **statue of Rocky Balboa**; re-enact his run up the steps to the **Philadelphia Museum of Art**.

FAYETTEVILLE, WEST VIRGINIA, AND NEW RIVER GORGE NATIONAL PARK

Enjoy the scenic mountains, breathtaking gorge views and activities at New River Gorge National Park and Preserve. Steeped in history and flush with outdoor recreation, this is a perfect place to take a break from your road trip. Set on over 28,000 hectares along the New River, it's a great place to go whitewater rafting, kayaking, or hiking to spectacular

waterfalls and other scenic places. For a memory you will never forget, take the **Bridge Walk** across the gorge 244 meters above the **New River**. The park is a year-round destination and offers activities every season.

FAYETTEVILLE, WEST VIRGINIA, TO WHITE SULPHUR SPRINGS, WEST VIRGINIA

Admire the spectacular scenery and lookout points driving east along the **Midland Trail** to colonial **Lewisburg**. Known for its historic landmarks, vibrant art community, and an assortment of boutiques and restaurants, this is a great stop for lunch and exploring. A short distance from Lewisburg, stop in **White Sulphur Springs** in the **Allegheny Mountains**. It is famous for its spring waters and home to the famous **Greenbrier Resort**, where you'll sleep tonight. Tour the once-secret Cold War-era bunker beneath the Greenbrier, built to house U.S. Congress members should there be a nuclear war.

WHITE SULPHUR SPRINGS, WEST VIRGINIA, TO LURAY, VIRGINIA

Today's drive will take you into **Virginia** via the **Blue Ridge Parkway** east of **Lexington**. Connecting the **Great Smoky Mountains** to **Shenandoah National Park**, the parkway is famous for its breathtaking vistas and close-up views of the **Appalachian Mountains**. The parkway meets **Skyline Drive** just east of **Waynesboro** and traverses through the central part of **Shenandoah National Park**. This unique stretch covers over 160 kilometers at a leisurely speed limit of 56 kilometers an hour. Stretch your legs by hiking in the unforgettable surroundings if time allows. Tonight, you will stay in the Shenandoah Valley in the town of **Luray**, known for the **Luray Caverns**. The underground cave system includes the Great Stalacpipe Organ, named because the lithophone prompts the stalactite mineral formations to make musical sounds.

Explore this amazing city, which is both the capital of the USA and home to legendary museums, such as the **Smithsonian Institution** and the **National Air and Space Museum**. Its awe-inspiring sites include the **Washington Monument** and the **National Mall**. The city also is the political center of the USA, and you'll want to see the spectacular domed **U.S. Capitol building**. Venture into the city's historic

neighborhoods – lunch along the **Southwest Waterfront** is a favorite for locals and tourists. Take an evening stroll in **Georgetown** along narrow cobbled streets lined with boutiques, art galleries and unique restaurants.
