




JOSHUA TREE NATIONAL PARK

The extraordinary landscape of world-famous Joshua Tree National Park is less than an hour's drive from Greater Palm Springs. Park adventures include incredible hiking trails, rock climbing, guided walks, evening programs and special events.

After exploring the park, check out the eclectic restaurants and antique shops that line the main drag of this laidback town. While heading back to Greater Palm Springs, stop by the Old West movie set town of Pioneertown and dine in one of the region's favorite watering holes: Pappy and Harriet's Pioneertown Palace.
