

## TRANSPORTATION

You'll find that it is easy to get to – and get around – Philadelphia!

### FROM THE AIRPORT

SEPTA's Airport Line leaves every 30 minutes, and a one-way fare is \$6.75. To drive into Center City, take a 25-minute taxi ride, with a flat rate of \$32, or a ride-sharing service.

### PARKING

There are more than 40 public parking lots and garages, plus metered street parking (read signs carefully for parking hours) in Center City. To pay for metered parking, you can use a variety of payment methods, including credit cards, at one of the green kiosks. Some parking zones are supported by the ParkMobile app (available for Android and iOS), and the MeterUp app, which allows you to pay for and extend your parking time via your mobile device. ### SEPTA

Hop on a SEPTA bus, subway, trolley or train for easy access to top attractions throughout the city. View a full list of public transit stations, routes and fares at [septa.org/welcome](http://septa.org/welcome).

The Philly PHLASH® Downtown Loop is visitor-friendly, convenient and affordable public transit with stops located near popular tourist destinations and top holiday attractions throughout the city. 

## FROM ESSENTIAL FAVORITES...

It's not a trip to Philadelphia without trying a cheesesteak. Shops selling the trademark sandwich — tender pieces of beef combined with melted cheese on a fresh Italian roll — are practically on every corner. Two of Philadelphia's most iconic shops — **Pat's King of Steaks** and **Geno's Steaks** — are located across the street from one another in the East Passyunk neighborhood.

Arguably the cheese-steak's more refined cousin, the roast-pork sandwich has an equally fervent local fanbase and is made with thin-sliced pork served on a sesame-

seed long roll with sharp provolone and broccoli rabe. The most famous version is available from **DiNic's Roast Pork** in the **Reading Terminal Market**.

Soft pretzels are the ultimate comfort food for Philadelphians. Baked fresh every day and available at street vendors, local stores or directly from the factory, these salty satisfiers are delicious with spicy mustard. Several stalls in the Reading Terminal Market offer freshly baked pretzels, including the **Pennsylvania General Store**.

Thanks to a gastronomic scene that exudes creativity, Philadelphia catapults innovative chefs and restaurants into James Beard Award-winning fame and beckons food enthusiasts worldwide.

The 2023 James Beard winner for Outstanding Restaurant, **Friday Saturday Sunday** in Rittenhouse Square presents a sophisticated eight-course tasting menu that is seasonally inspired and rooted in classics.


Authentic Thai cuisine prepared with Southern

Thai traditional family recipes awaits visitors at **Kalaya** in Fishtown, whose owner Chutatip "Nok" Suntaranon was named the 2023 Best Chef: Mid Atlantic at the James Beard Awards.

The 2023 Award for Outstanding Restaurateur was presented to Ellen Yin, the driving force behind High Street Hospitality, which features a wide spectrum of must-try dining, including boutique bakery **High Street on Market** and elevated Mediterranean eatery **Fork** in Old City.

# America's

## FOUNDING CITY



Liberty Bell

### PHILADELPHIA IS THE UNITED STATES' FIRST WORLD HERITAGE CITY.

Home to 68 National Historical Landmarks and America's "most historic square mile," Philadelphia is where the Founding Fathers adopted ideas for an independent new nation.

**Independence National Historical Park** is a robust collection of sites that includes **Independence Hall** — where the Declaration of Independence was signed on July 4, 1776, and the Constitution was written and debated — and the **Liberty Bell**, as well as the Benjamin Franklin Museum, Franklin Court Printing Office, the Second Bank of the United States and more.

**The President's House** on Independence Mall marks the footprint of the residence of presidents George Washington and John Adams while in office, while also telling the story of the enslaved people who built and worked in the house.

**Congress Hall** oversaw two major presidential inaugurations, starting with the swearing-in of George Washington for his second term in 1793.

Site of the first Continental Congress in 1774, today **Carpenters' Hall** displays hand tools, the chairs used by Founding Fathers and other historical artifacts.

**Christ Church Burial Ground**

Tour the home of reported American flag-maker **Betsy Ross** to learn about her interaction with the Founding Fathers from the famed seamstress herself.

Step back in time on carefully preserved **Elfreth's Alley** — the nation's oldest continuously inhabited street.

**The American Philosophical Society** was co-founded by Ben Franklin in 1743, and its museum is a treasure trove of historic items, including a draft of the Declaration of Independence.

Founded in 1695, **Christ Church & Burial Ground** was the place of worship for numerous Founding Fathers. Benjamin Franklin's tomb can be found in the church's burial ground.

A block from Independence Hall is **Washington Square**, one of the city's original squares, and home to the memorial to Washington and unknown soldiers of the American Revolution.

**The National Constitution Center** brings the U.S. Constitution to life through multimedia exhibits, engaging performances and historic artifacts.

Enjoy the crisp, cool air and comfortable temperatures while exploring all there is to do. The city's autumn calendar is full of festive events and activities.

### FAIRMOUNT PARK & KELLY DRIVE

Admire breathtaking foliage in the more than 2,000-acre outdoor playground of **Fairmount Park**, one of the largest city-owned urban park systems in the world. Start at the historic **Shofuso Japanese House and Garden**, a replica of a traditional 17th-century Japanese home. Then head to the **Horticulture Center**, where you can explore the vast outdoors or learn more in the greenhouse. Or venture to **Morris Arboretum & Gardens**, a nearly 100-acre property home to some of the city's oldest and rarest trees. Go for a walk or run along **Kelly Drive** to take in even more fall color with trees lining the trails along the Schuylkill River.

### FIVE ORIGINAL SQUARES

Spend an autumn afternoon strolling through one of the city's five original squares – **Dilworth Park**, **Franklin Square**, **Logan Square**, **Rittenhouse Square** and **Washington Square**. Embrace the cooler temperatures while taking in all the seasonal hues of fall in the city.

### CHARMING SIDE STREETS

USA Today's 10Best Readers' Choice Awards named Philadelphia the 2023 Most Walkable City in the U.S., and the fall season offers even more reasons to explore the city by foot. Stroll through the city's tree-filled neighborhoods and charming side streets, including **Quince Street** in Washington Square West and **Addison Street** and **Panama Street** in Rittenhouse Square for photo-worthy fall views.

### THE COUNTRYSIDE OF PHILADELPHIA

The Countryside of Philadelphia is home to **Longwood Gardens**, a world-renowned 1,077-acre estate blooming with memorable gardens and a breathtaking conservatory. Don't miss the annual Chrysanthemum Festival, which honors fall's favorite flower.

For a ghostly good time, visitors can navigate the 18th-century former home of the patriotic seamstress and **learn more about the city’s macabre past**. Inside, visitors will hear chilling, true stories about the bloodletting horrors of living in Philadelphia during the time of the Revolution.

**GHOST TOUR OF PHILADELPHIA**

*Nightly*

Discover the eerie past of Philadelphia’s most historic sites on a **Ghost Tour of Philadelphia**. These **candlelit walking tours** are led by knowledgeable guides through the historic streets at night. Visit **historical houses believed to have a spiritual presence** while hearing ghost stories and creepy tales from Philadelphia’s past.

Historians believe this Philadelphia house is where Poe penned some of his most iconic works, including “The Black Cat.” And don’t miss a mural of Poe just across the street. Visitors can tour the house for free Fridays through Sundays.



Philadelphia Christmas Village

Ice skating, pop-up markets, festive light shows and beloved holiday performances are just a few of the seasonal activities to make your Philadelphia visit merry and bright in November and December.

### PHILADELPHIA CHRISTMAS VILLAGE

This is the city's authentic **German Christmas market**, held in **LOVE Park** and the north apron of **City Hall** in **Center City**. Every year, more than 100 local artisans and makers sell handcrafted goods out of traditional **German wooden shopping stalls** alongside a **beer garden**, **food stands**, a **carousel**, **Ferris wheel** and a **Kids Train**.

### MADE IN PHILADELPHIA HOLIDAY MARKET

This market features **dozens of makers** from across the region who sell holiday-inspired crafts, gifts and other goods in **Dilworth Park** (west side of historic City Hall) in Center City.

### COMCAST TECHNOLOGY CENTER HOLIDAY SPECTACULAR

Visitors are welcomed into the lobby of the **Comcast Technology Center** to watch performances by the **Philadelphia Ballet**, who perform to classic holiday songs on a massive screen. The 15-minute **family-friendly show** plays daily. If you're hungry afterward, head downstairs to **The Concourse at Comcast Center**, a food court filled with casual dining options.

### THE MIRACLE ON SOUTH 13TH STREET

Residents along the **1600 block of South 13th Street** in the **East Passyunk neighborhood** team up to create a **stunning holiday display** made up of more than 300,000 lights strung along the street, crossing from house to house overhead. Each building features its own holiday theme.



The lights dance along to classic tunes from the **Wanamaker Organ**, the largest playable instrument in the world. **Macy's Dickens Village** is a 6,000-square-foot walk-through experience featuring 26 scenes from **Charles Dickens' holiday classic, "A Christmas Carol."**

### LUMINATURE AT PHILADELPHIA ZOO

**LumiNature at Philadelphia Zoo** features dozens of illuminating, animal-themed displays, experience zones and other creative displays, light shows and holiday activities spread throughout the grounds of the nation's first zoo.

### TINSELTOWN HOLIDAY SPECTACULAR

For the first time ever, **Tinseltown Holiday Spectacular** is coming to **FDR Park in South Philadelphia**. Walk through an immersive environment filled with gigantic seasonal light displays as visitors of all ages enjoy snowtubing, ice skating and seasonal snacks.

### CHRISTMAS UNDERWATER AT ADVENTURE AQUARIUM

Home to the largest collection of sharks in the Northeast, **Adventure Aquarium's Christmas Underwater** special event features "sea"-sonal fun, such as appearances by **Scuba Santa**, who dives daily among the sea turtles, sharks and stingrays, and poses for selfies.

### A LONGWOOD CHRISTMAS

Stroll the 1,000-acre property during **A Longwood Christmas** to admire beautifully decorated trees and other holiday displays as the property glows with half-a-million strung holiday lights.

### HANUKKAH CELEBRATIONS

Celebrate Hanukkah at the **Betsy Ross House's** menorah lighting, hosted in partnership with the **Old City Jewish Arts Center**. Festivities include traditional treats like latkes and jelly donuts. Children will be given dreidels and menorahs, while supplies last.



**WEITZMAN NATIONAL MUSEUM OF AMERICAN JEWISH HISTORY**

This museum details the Jewish experience in America starting in 1654. The first floor features the "Only in America" gallery — an exhibition illustrating the choices, challenges and opportunities Jewish Americans encountered in America.







Then wander **Philadelphia's Magic Gardens**, a mesmerizing, indoor and outdoor mosaic labyrinth along South Street.

TOUR WORLD-RENOWNED MUSEUMS

View an unparalleled collection of impressionist, post-impressionist and modern paintings at the **Philadelphia Museum of Art** and the **Barnes Foundation**. The Philadelphia Museum of Art is home to nearly 200 galleries including the world's largest collection of works by artist Marcel Duchamp. The Barnes Foundation is home to pieces by Cezanne, Matisse and Modigliani, along with more than 180 pieces by Renoir — the largest collection of works by the artist in the world.

HEAD TO THE AVENUE OF THE ARTS

See magical musicals, spectacular shows and outstanding orchestras and operas at venues along South Broad Street. Take in a performance of "Charles Dickens' A Christmas Carol" December 2–17 at the **Walnut Street Theatre** — the oldest theater in America — not far from the Avenue of the Arts.

# Family-Friendly PHILADELPHIA

If you're traveling with kids, Philadelphia has fun to spare. The city offers activities, fantastic food and opportunities to make lasting memories together.

Enter the world of wow at the **Please Touch Museum** — the children's museum of Philadelphia. Little ones will giggle with joy as they travel into the pages of classic stories in the Fairytale Garden and navigate the Mad Hatter's hedge maze. The museum goes beyond entertainment — it's an educational journey where children learn about ecosystems and the economy as they play.

The **Philadelphia Zoo** — the nation's oldest — gives kids close views of their favorite species. Tigers, gorillas and other animals roam overhead in the Zoo360 trail, a see-through mesh trail above the zoo grounds. Look for seasonal activities like Boo

at the Zoo — their annual Halloween celebration — and LumiNature, a spectacular holiday-light show.

Inspired by Benjamin Franklin — and home to his national memorial — **The Franklin Institute** is known for its all-ages, hands-on exploration of key science concepts. Exhibits include a giant walk-through heart, planetarium and immersive brain exhibit.

Explore lifesize dioramas and fossils at the **Academy of Natural Sciences of Drexel University** — the first natural-sciences museum in the Americas. Inside Dinosaur Hall, kids can marvel at more than 30 different types of fossils, including a complete (and stunning) Tyrannosaurus-rex skeleton.

Set sail for the **Independence Seaport Museum**, where families adventure through America's maritime history. Learn how rivers impact our daily lives and then climb aboard one of the two historic ships docked nearby — the stunning Cruiser Olympia and the Submarine Becuna.

**Franklin Square** is a Philadelphia classic, brimming with playgrounds, mini golf and an old-fashioned carousel. The nearly 200-year-old fountain puts on a memorable show throughout the year. When the temperature drops, Franklin Square transforms into a winter wonderland with a holiday-light show and Chilly Philly Mini-Golf.



Tour the **Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts**, the oldest art museum and art school in the nation. Walk under the **Friendship Gate**, a gift from Philadelphia's sister city of Tianjin, which welcomes visitors to **Chinatown**. Visit the free **Fabric Workshop and Museum**, a modern-art exhibition space whose unique artist-in-residence program results in one-of-a-kind collaborations with internationally renowned artists.

**DINE:** Satisfy just about any craving at the historic **Reading Terminal Market**, home to more than 80 independent vendors and 30 eateries. Grab a drink at **McGillin's Olde Ale House** — the city's oldest continuously operating tavern — or settle in for an evening of live jazz at **Chris' Jazz Café**. Savor the best duck in the city in Chinatown's local favorite, **Sang Kee Peking Duck House**.

# RITTENHOUSE SQUARE

Rittenhouse Square

**A EUROPEAN-LIKE SQUARE IN THE MIDDLE OF PHILADELPHIA, RITTENHOUSE SQUARE IS KNOWN FOR ITS PICTURESQUE PARK, UPSCALE SHOPPING AND AL FRESCO DINING.**

**DO:** Home to a collection of more than 25,000 medical specimens and instruments, the iconic **Mütter Museum** is dedicated to displaying fascinating discoveries about the human body. The **Rosenbach Museum** holds a private collection of noted rare books, including the only surviving copy of Benjamin Franklin's first "Poor Richard's Almanack" and Bram Stoker's notes for "Dracula." For late-night fun, reserve an Olympic-grade ping-pong table at **SPIN Philadelphia**, a ping-pong social club.

**DINE:** Enjoy a Parisian brasserie experience at **Parc**, complete with outdoor seating along the square. Chef Amanda Shulman's **Her Place Supper Club** is like a dinner party with an ever-changing menu of Italian and French fare. **Gran Caffè L'Aquila** serves authentic Italian delicacies from a building moved here from Italy.

## GAYBORHOOD/WASHINGTON SQUARE WEST

**THE PULSE OF WASHINGTON SQUARE WEST IN PHILADELPHIA IS ALWAYS BEATING AS LIVELY DINING, ENTRANCING PERFORMANCES AND VIBRANT NIGHTLIFE FILL THIS QUIANT HISTORIC NEIGHBORHOOD.**

**DO:** Founded in 1751 by Benjamin Franklin and Dr. Thomas Bond, **Pennsylvania Hospital** is the nation's first hospital and boasts the inaugural surgical amphitheater and medical library, both accessible on tours of the historic **Pine Building**. Headlining Broad Street, the **Kimmel Cultural Campus** is a collection of performing-arts venues, including the **Academy of Music** and the **Miller Theater**, where visiting Broadway tours perform. The campus is also home to the **Philadelphia Orchestra**, one of America's "Big Five" symphony orchestras.

**DINE:** For breakfast, the pillowy egg sandwiches at **Middle Child** are an absolute must-try. **Charlie was a sinner** specializes in vegan offerings, pairing small, plant-based plates with an exceptional lineup of artisan cocktails. The intimate lounge and incredible chefs' tasting menu make dinner at **Double Knot** unforgettable. And don't miss the Sunday gravy at **Little Nonna's**, a red sauce transporting patrons to Italy.





To enjoy more live entertainment, catch rising acts at **Johnny Brenda's**, **Ortlieb's**, **The Fire** or **Heritage**.

**DINE:** **Laser Wolf** serves visitors a salatin spread of Israeli delicacies made on a charcoal grill, intensifying its subjects' flavor. An art gallery, bookstore and music venue all in one, **LMNO** is a Baja Mexican restaurant with a menu as diverse and captivating as its concept. A "comfortable place to be," **Murph's Bar** is a friendly Irish pub full of character and deliciously authentic Italian dishes.

## FAIRMOUNT/PARKWAY MUSEUM DISTRICT

**DO:** See Dr. Albert Barnes' eclectic collection of impressionist, post-impressionist and early modern art at the **Barnes Foundation**. Emerging above the Benjamin Franklin Parkway, **The Philadelphia Museum of Art** houses a triumphant collection of paintings, sculptures, decorative arts and architectural settings from Europe, Asia and the Americas. Kept in "preserved ruin," **Eastern State Penitentiary** invites visitors to stroll through its haunting halls to learn about former inhabitants, including Al Capone.

**DINE:** Atop the Logan Hotel is **Assembly**, a rooftop bar with picturesque views, serving equally stunning craft cocktails and charcuterie. On Fairmount Avenue, **Bar Hygge** is a cozy brewpub focusing on neighborhood comfort food. Those on the go can get quick bites from chef-driven establishments such as **Pizzeria Vetri** and **Buena Onda Tacos**.

## UNIVERSITY CITY/WEST PHILADELPHIA

**HOME TO THE UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA AND DREXEL UNIVERSITY CAMPUSES, WEST PHILADELPHIA IS A FOLKSY NEIGHBORHOOD WITH DIVERSE RESTAURANTS AND COMMUNITY PRIDE.**

**DO:** On the University of Pennsylvania campus, explore priceless archaeological artifacts from around the globe — including the largest sphinx in the western hemisphere — at the **Penn Museum**. Take in a theater, dance or world-music performance at **Penn Live Arts** and view installations from up-and-coming artists at the **Institute of Contemporary Art**, home of Andy Warhol's first solo show.

**DINE:** Reserve a table or grab a quick snack to go from **Walnut Street Café**, which prepares hot American plates, breakfast through dinner. A neighborhood staple, **Sabrina's Café** is a brunch haven, serving both breakfast classics and specials inspired by blockbuster movies. **Baltimore Avenue** is the go-to street for international dining, lined with Mediterranean, Indian, Mexican and Thai cuisine, such as **Booker's Restaurant & Bar**, serving worldly takes on traditional Southern-inspired dishes.







At Brandywine Valley, explore the grounds of **Longwood Gardens**, complete with ethereal indoor and outdoor gardens featuring seasonal displays. 




