 downtown Kings Beach. The next Get S'mores Saturdays
 will take place on February 23 and March 9.
- Granlibakken Tahoe in Tahoe City is home to an epic sledding hill and beautiful fire pit, perfect for s'mores with the family. Enjoy a day of snowy fun with your kids on the family-friendly sledding hill, then purchase a s'more kits from the Ski Hut Snack Bar and snuggle up around fire pits for some delicious treats.
- West Shore Cafe in Homewood offers Après-ski s'more specials for a special evening treat. After a day on the slopes at Homewood Mountain Resort, hop across the street to West Shore Cafe to craft some complimentary s'mores on their lakefront patio and indulge in happy hour deals on cocktails.
