WHAT'S NEW IN NEW ORLEANS

VUE ORLEANS:

An interactive cultural exhibit with a 360° observation deck on the 34th floor of the Four Seasons.

EXPRESSIONS OF AMERICA AT THE NATIONAL WWII MUSEUM:

Expressions of America uniquely combines the latest outdoor projection technology with wartime letters and oral histories from the Museum's collection to allow audiences to experience the stories of the WWII generation like never before.

HAMPTON INN FRENCH QUARTER MARKET HOTEL:

Opened March 2023. One block from the popular Frenchmen Street, on the edge of the French Quarter. Offers free breakfast, an indoor pool, valet parking, and is pet-friendly

CAESARS NEW ORLEANS:

Following a multimillion-dollar transformation, Harrah's New Orleans Hotel & Casino will become Caesars New Orleans in late 2024. A new 340-room hotel tower, that includes two dedicated floors of Nobu rooms and suites, will bring the total guestroom count to 790.

HOTEL TONNELLE NEW ORLEANS:

Formerly the Hotel Indigo New Orleans, now part of Marriott's Tribute Portfolio brand, Hotel Tonnelle offers a modern, New Orleans experience along the St. Charles streetcar line in the Garden District neighborhood.

AUDUBON AQUARIUM AND INSECTARIUM:

After undergoing the largest renovation since opening, the reimagined, expanded, and now combined Audubon Aquarium and Insectarium reopened in June 2023.

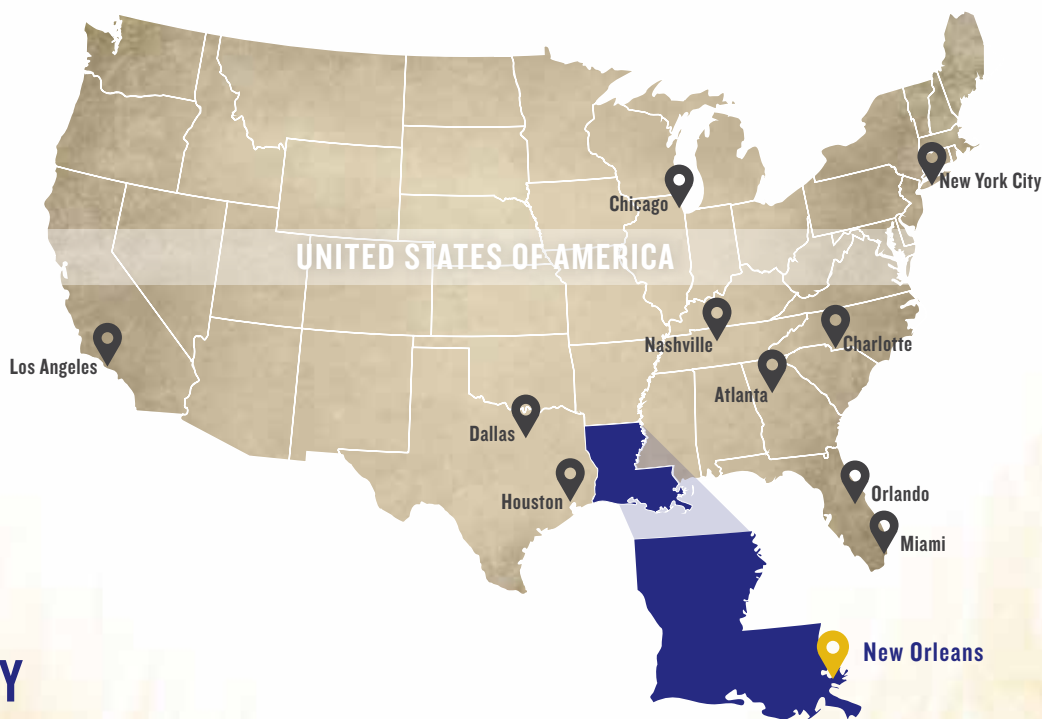
