Day 1: Atlanta, Georgia → Augusta, Georgia → Hilton Head, South Carolina

Tickets are available via the club website through a lottery.

Savor lunch at the renowned Frog Hollow Tavern, known for its sophisticated Southern cuisine, or sample fresh seafood dishes at Rhinehart's Oyster Bar. Following lunch, continue your drive for approximately 2.5 hours to Hilton Head Island. Enjoy the scenic drive through charming coastal landscapes, arriving late afternoon to check into your hotel.

Enjoy a relaxing dinner at Hudson's Seafood House on the Docks or Skull Creek Boathouse, offering panoramic waterfront dining experiences. After dinner, unwind with a gentle evening stroll around Shelter Cove Towne Centre, taking in the relaxed coastal atmosphere and local boutique shops.

Day 2: Hilton Head, South Carolina

For dinner, experience the upscale dining atmosphere of The Sage Room or experience fresh American seafood specialties at Red Fish. Finish your evening with drinks and live music at Poseidon Rooftop Bar, enjoying the island's vibrant nightlife.

Day 3: Hilton Head, South Carolina → Savannah, Georgia

Start today with a leisurely breakfast at Java Burrito Company before a 45-minute drive to historic Savannah. Here, you can admire elegant squares and vibrant architecture and visit landmarks like Forsyth Park and the striking Cathedral of St. John the Baptist.

For lunch, experience the warmth and southern hospitality of Mrs. Wilkes Dining Room, famed for its hearty family-style meals. Afterward, delve deeper into Savannah's cultural heritage by strolling through its historic cobblestone streets or embarking on an adventurous ghost tour, where you can learn about the city's intriguing legends and mysteries.

In the evening, savor a memorable meal at The Olde Pink House, a classic Southern dining establishment in a historic mansion. Afterward, enjoy an expertly crafted cocktail at Alley Cat Lounge or take in the stunning rooftop views at Peregrin.
