# BEYOND THE CITY ———

## **SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA**

Cruise one and a half hours down the coast to vibrant San Diego, where sunshine and storytelling go hand in hand. Begin in the historic old quarter, where charming adobe buildings and market-style plazas set the tone for the day. Art and architecture await in the city's sprawling cultural park, while the coast beckons with the marine life and rocky beauty of La Jolla's sea cliffs. Paddle out into the coves or stroll the surf-kissed boardwalks before enjoying a breezy lunch at a seaside café. As evening falls, sip cocktails from a stylish rooftop with sweeping views over the bay and skyline.

## **PALM SPRINGS, CALIFORNIA**

Venture two hours inland through mountain passes and wind farms to reach the retro-chic desert playground of Palm Springs. Ride the tramway to Alpine Heights for breathtaking valley views or explore the town's vibrant mix of art, architecture, and design. The streets are lined with palm trees and pastel façades, perfect for a leisurely walk or gallery hop. Cool off with lunch in a stylish courtyard or beneath desert palms, then stretch out by the pool or discover ancient palm oases on a shaded canyon hike. #### **MALIBU, CALIFORNIA**

Start your morning on a tranquil stretch of sand like El Matador Beach, where tide pools and sea caves add a touch of the wild. Dive into local history at a historic oceanfront estate, then dine with waves at your feet at one of Malibu's chic coastal restaurants. Spend your afternoon exploring surf shops or savoring local wines by the sea as the golden sun fades behind the waves.

## **SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA**

Head two and a half hours north for a coastal drive to Santa Barbara, where Spanish-style villas and sun-washed hillsides set the stage for a laid-back yet elegant retreat. Visit the historic mission perched above town, then explore art galleries and tasting rooms in the lively Funk Zone district. Outdoor enthusiasts can kayak along the coast or hike up to scenic overlooks with sweeping views of the Channel Islands. Savor dinner in the heart of downtown, where twinkle-lit patios and fresh seafood await. End your day with a drink on a rooftop terrace as the sun dips behind the Santa Ynez Mountains.

## **DEL MAR, CALIFORNIA**

North of San Diego and one and a half hours south of Irvine lies Del Mar, a refined coastal village with a splash of Southern California cool. Begin your day walking the ocean bluffs at Seagrove Park or relaxing on the soft sands below. In racing season, the sound of hooves at the historic track adds excitement, while boutique shops and art galleries offer a more leisurely pace. Savor ocean-view dining with locally inspired dishes, then kick back with a craft beer beside the calm waters of a coastal lagoon. With its effortless charm and natural beauty, Del Mar wraps you in laid-back luxury.
